## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

### Registration

#### **Can I register as an individual?**

The Workshop is open only to organisations. You can register as a representative of your organisation.

#### **How many representatives from each organisation can attend the Workshop?**

Each organisation is allowed up to two representatives due to limited seats available.

#### **My co-workers and I are interested to register for the Workshop. Do we put in two registrations?**

No. If you are registering with your co-workers, you may register for up to 2 registrants per organisation.

#### **Do I have to look for other organisations to register for the Workshop?**

No. However, organisations are strongly encouraged to register with at least one other organisation to bring together diverse background and expertise and bring about cross-learning and collaboration.

#### **Can the same organisation submit more than one registration form if the organisation has more than one team working on different ideas?**

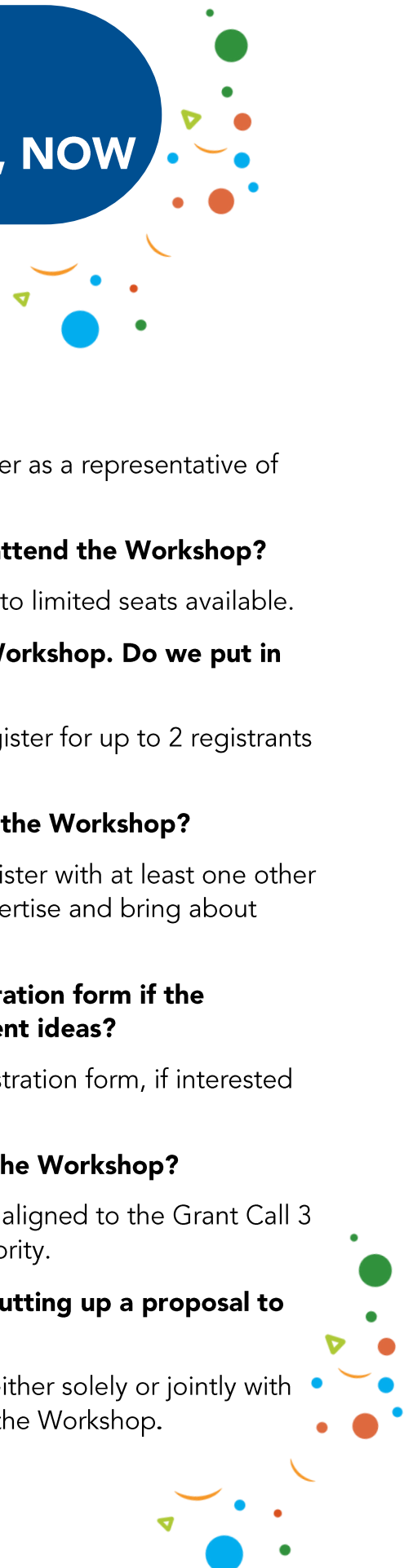
Yes, the same organisation may submit more than one registration form, if interested participants are working on distinct project ideas.

#### **Must I have a project idea to be eligible to register for the Workshop?**

No. However, registrants who have indicated ideas that are aligned to the Grant Call 3 theme and problem statement will be given registration priority.

#### **Can I register if I am uncertain about whether I will be putting up a proposal to ELI Grant?**

We hope for all participants to ultimately have a proposal, either solely or jointly with other Workshop participants to the ELI Grant at the end of the Workshop.



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#### Fees

##### **Are there any fees payable to attend the Workshop?**

No.

#### Participation

##### **Do I have to attend the matching session, all 5 workshop sessions and self-guided activities?**

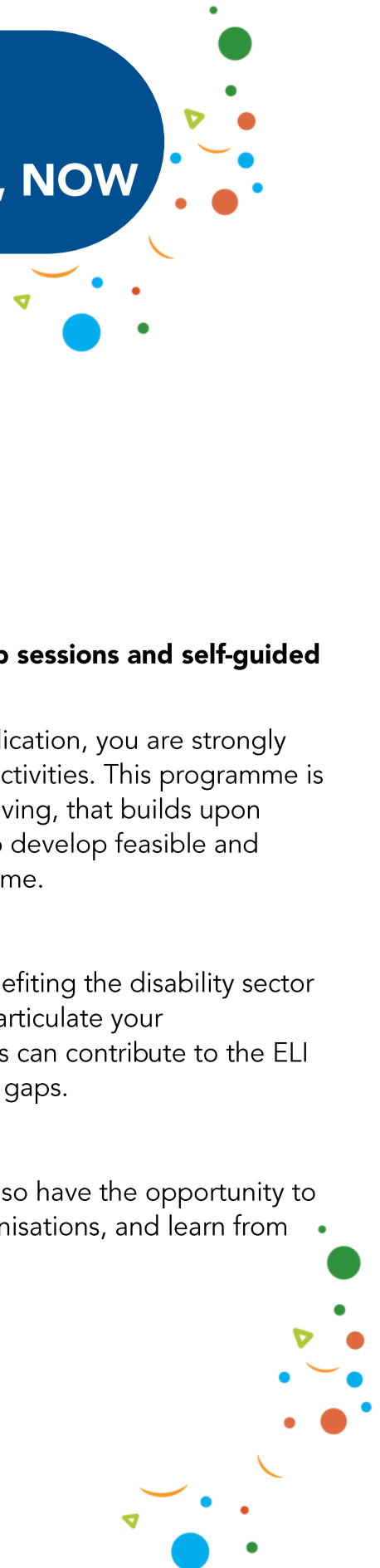
As the Workshop is to better prepare you in your grant application, you are strongly encouraged to follow through all sessions and self-guided activities. This programme is designed to be an iterative process for creative problem-solving, that builds upon previous workshop outputs, thereby allowing participants to develop feasible and holistic solutions that meet the ELI Grant objectives and theme.

##### **What will I as a participant learn from the Workshop?**

Participants will learn how to develop holistic proposals benefiting the disability sector using Design Thinking concepts. You will also learn how to articulate your understanding of the issues and how the proposed solutions can contribute to the ELI Grant objectives and theme, and meet the identified sector gaps.

##### **What else can I look forward to from the Workshop?**

In addition to learning Design Thinking concepts, you will also have the opportunity to meet and co-develop solutions with other like-minded organisations, and learn from one another.



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### Participation

#### How will the Workshop be conducted?

The Workshop and the matching session will be held at the Enabling Village, 20 Lengkok Bahru Singapore 159053, subject to prevailing regulatory Safe Distancing Measures.

#### If my collaborator did not register for the programme, will we still be eligible to submit an application to the ELI Grant?

Yes. Registration for the programme is not a prerequisite to apply for ELI Grant. However, we strongly encourage you and your potential collaborator(s) to participate and complete the Workshop which would go a long way to ensuring that you deliver a strong proposal.

### Coaching Session

#### What can I expect from the coaching sessions?

The coaching sessions are 30 - 60 min sessions with individual teams for facilitators to provide feedback and guidance to the team, to optimise insights and solutioning to help in the development of a strong grant application and a compelling pitch for the proposal by the end of the Workshop.
